Where is registration?

There are a 2 options for registration. Either email or mail!

Email option. VERY IMPORTANT TO FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS ON EMAILING

2. IN THE SUBJECT YOU MUST HAVE GENDER, AGE, TEAM ID (NUMBER THAT STARTS WITH MOTORCITY) Example: Boys U8 MOTORCITY55555555
3. Send as one continuous document preferably a PDF file. Do not want each document attached separately. Please read below as to what documents we

This email address is NOT to ask questions. You will not receive a response to questions, only acknowledgment that we received your materials and everything is correct.

Mail in Option:

1. You can send materials to Motor City Champions Cup 24404 Catherine Industrial Suite 310, Novi, MI 48375 . Please do not send originals, copies only.

What you need to mail/email is:

1. a copy of passcards
2. guest player roster (if applies)
3. copy of risk management card for coach (kid safe card) (does not apply to foreign teams)
4. a copy of your roster.
5. Liability Release Form
6. Contact info sheet
7. Copy of travel permit, if applies
8. Copy of coaches concussion certificate (all coaches must have) **AS WELL AS MANAGER**
9. We do not need copies of but you should have copy of your medical release/liability forms from your league and copy of Concussion Parent Athlete form (this form can be found on website under FORMS section)
IF YOU CHOOSE TO DO THE MAIL IN OPTION THEN ALL MATERIALS MUST BE RECEIVED BY August 29th

THEM AT ALL TIMES DURING THE GAMES. IN CASE OF INJURY, YOU DO NOT HAVE TO PROVIDE A COPY, YOU SHOULD HAVE MEDICAL RELEASE FORMS.

We will also accept US Club Rosters and Passcards

If you have guest players it is a state sanctioning rule that you must fill out a guest player roster with your state affiliate. We do not supply those forms. For Michigan you can go to www.michiganyouthsoccer.org and click Forms, e-travel forms to fill that out and bring with you to registration. Other states must go to your state affiliate to get your forms

FAQ's

1. If a player already plays for another team in my club do I still have to get a guest player roster from MSYSA or my affiliated league for them?
YES, that is a state requirement that we as a sanctioned tournament must follow. You can go to www.michiganyouthsoccer.org and go to e-travel forms to get guest rosters. Out of state teams should contact their state association for information on obtaining these forms.
2. Can a player, play for more than one team?
NO, IMPORTANT: Players are only allowed to play for **ONE team** in the tournament. No player will be allowed to play for more than one team regardless of age group, gender or team. Teams that do not follow this rule will be disqualified. No double rostering allowed! This is another state sanctioning requirement.
3. Does everyone playing have to have a passcard or is a birth certificate okay?
Yes everyone has to have a passcard to play, that is how we know they are properly insured and No, a birth certificate is not accepted in place of a passcard.
4. How do I go about obtaining a passcard if a player does not have?
If in Michigan contact MSYSA, at www.michiganyouthsoccer.org or your state soccer association.
5. Can players help out (sub) on other teams?
Absolutely not, no double rostering of players. Whatever team they are rostered on for the tournament is the team they MUST play on and can not help out on another team.
6. Can I register at the fields before our game?
We would prefer you to mail or email in your registration. Our staff is very busy at the fields getting set up for games and handling issues. But if you have no choice then show up 1 hour prior to your first game, come to main tent and ask for site coordinator.
7. Once I mail or email my registration materials in, what do I need at fields?
Please make sure you have your passcards at every game. Field Marshals will be checking teams in AT FIELDS prior to the start of game. Also make sure you have your medical release forms, and copy of your roster at all times.
8. What happens if one of my players receives a red card?
We will need to take the passcard to insure the player does not play in the next game. We will then make sure the card gets back to coach/manager after the game in which the player needs to sit out.
